Hiking & Equestrian Trail Tips

- Let someone know where you are going and when you plan to return.
- Hike in a group, carry water and keep children close at hand.
 - Watch for signs of wildlife: scat, diggings, claw marks, etc.
 - Read all signs at the trailhead and stay on the trail.
 - Be aware of rattle snakes and small wildlife.
 - Avoid taking pets, they may attract wildlife.
 - Have fun and enjoy the scenery!

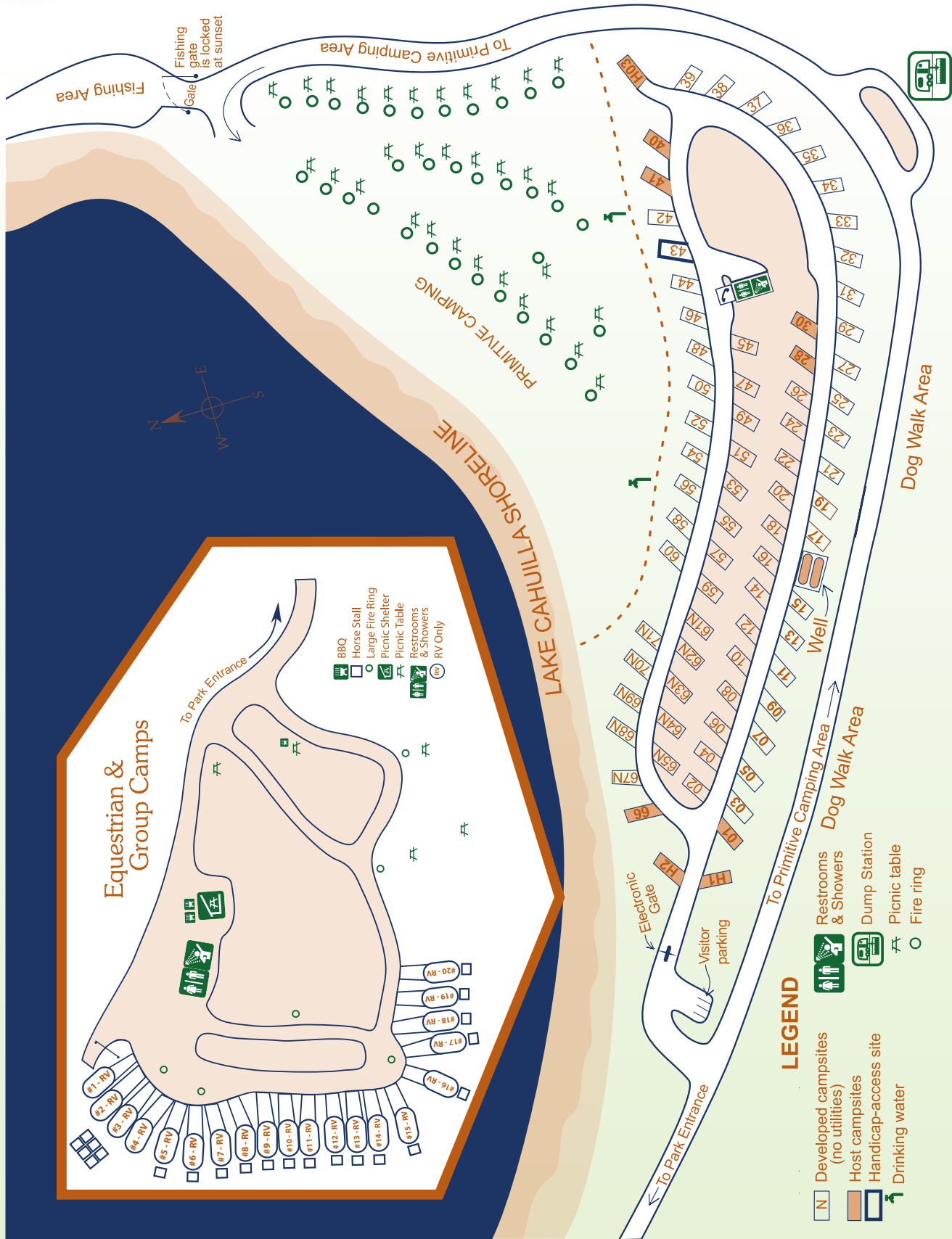
