he Crestmore Manor Campus has been home to RivCoParks headquarters since 1973 and is available as an event and conference venue year-round.

The Manor House, a 10,830 square-foot colonial-style mansion, was originally built in the mid 1950's by W.W. "Tiny" Naylor, a restaurateur and the state's second-leading thoroughbred breeder of the time, to appease his wife's desires to live in a home similar to the ones found in Kentucky's horse country. The Manor House serves as the iconic backdrop of the campus and is home to RivCoParks executive and administrative staff.

In 2006 a new event specific venue, the Carriage House, was constructed directly behind the main Manor House. The Carriage House can accommodate up to 200 guests and can be arranged in multiple configurations to meet your event needs.

In 2019, an expansion project was completed adding additional meeting and event space in the new Riverfront Room, expanding and updating the courtyard, and updating the A/V systems.
