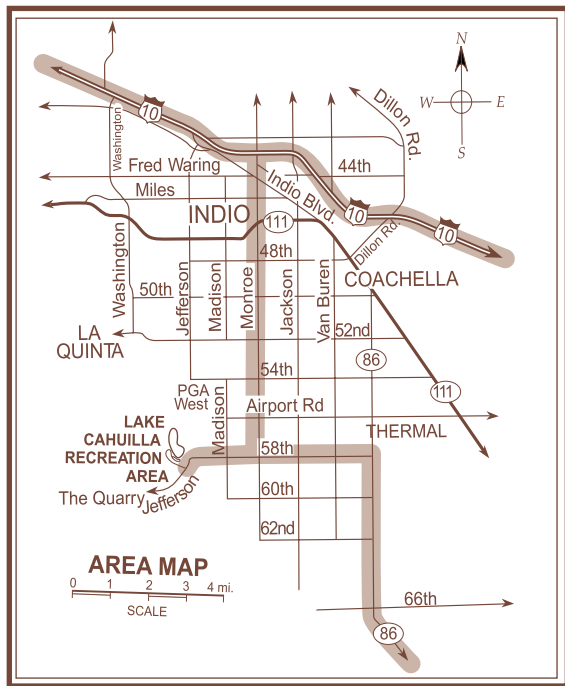


# Regional Map



## Finding Lake Cahuilla

### From L.A./Riverside/San Bernardino

Take I-10 east to Indio  
Exit at Monroe Street - RIGHT on Monroe  
Right on 58th  
Follow 58 until the road comes to a Y  
Take the right side of the Y to the facility

### From Blythe/Phoenix

Take I-10 west to Indio  
Exit at Monroe Street - LEFT on Monroe  
Right on 58th  
Follow 58 until the road comes to a Y  
Take the right side of the Y to the facility

### From Yuma/El Centro

Take Hwy 86 (86 S. Express Way) north from I-8  
Exit 86. Express Way on Airport Blvd.  
Left on Airport Blvd.  
Left on Madison  
Left on 58th  
Follow 58 until the road comes to a Y  
Take the right side of the Y to the facility

# Park Rules

## Bicycles

Riders must wear helmets.

## Campfires

Build fires only in safe, personal stoves, the grills/fire rings provided in designated picnic or camp sites. Over flow campfires must be self-contained and no less than 14" from the ground.  
**NO GROUND FIRES ALLOWED.**

## Campsite Occupancy

No more than six occupants and two vehicles per site. Maximum stay rule: 14 days within a 28-day period. Do not leave your site attended more than 24 hours.  
**VEHICLE INSURANCE AND REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED AT CHECK-IN**

## Driving

Abide by posted speed limits!  
No vehicles on the grass.

## Fishing:

Park fishing permit and California State Fishing License are required. State regulations apply. No night fishing.

## Fireworks and Firearms

**NO** fireworks.  
Possession of firearms of their use in the park is illegal.

## Natural Materials and Artifacts

Flowers, rocks, plants, animals, artifacts, and other park features are protected by County Ordinance #328. Do not remove, deface, or disturb any part of the park features or wildlife.  
Do NOT gather firewood in the park.  
Do NOT attach anything to trees.

## Pets

Pets must be kept on controlled leashes.  
(Maximum leash length - 6 feet.)  
Do not leave your pet unattended.  
No pets are permitted outdoors overnight.  
(10:00 p.m. - 6:00 a.m.)  
Clean up promptly after your pet.

## Quiet Hours

Quiet hours are enforced: 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.  
All generators and sound equipment off.  
(10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.)

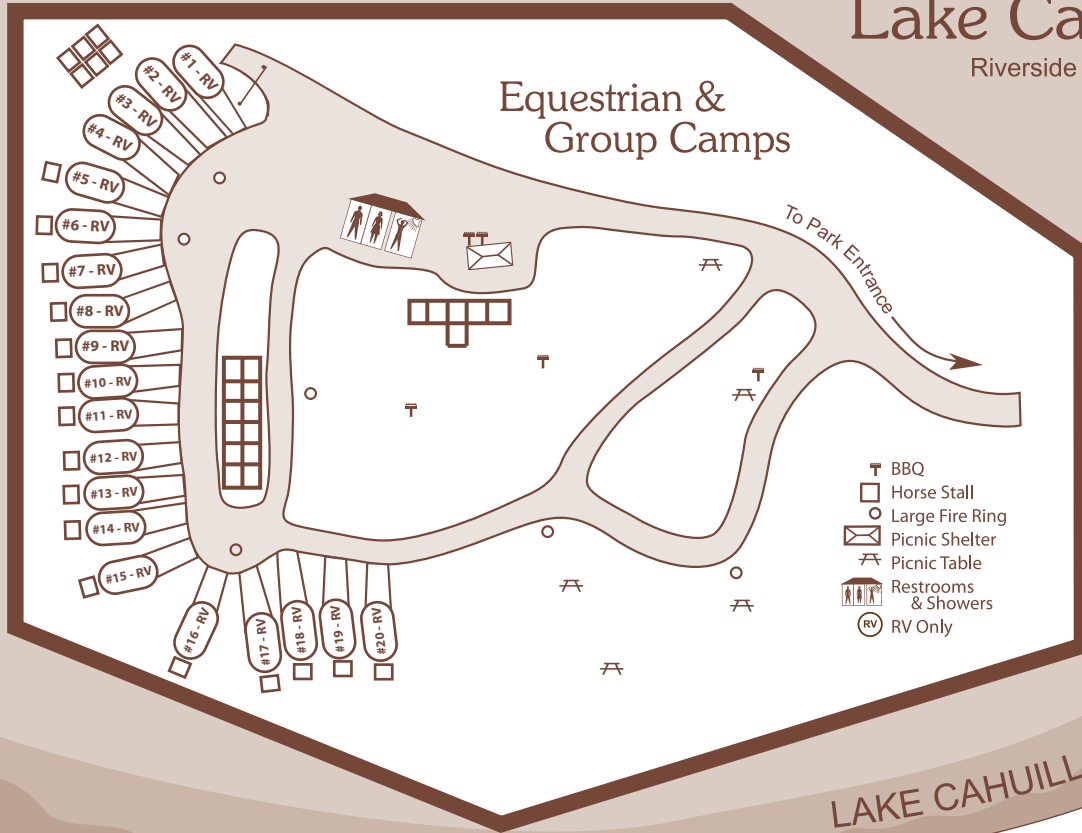

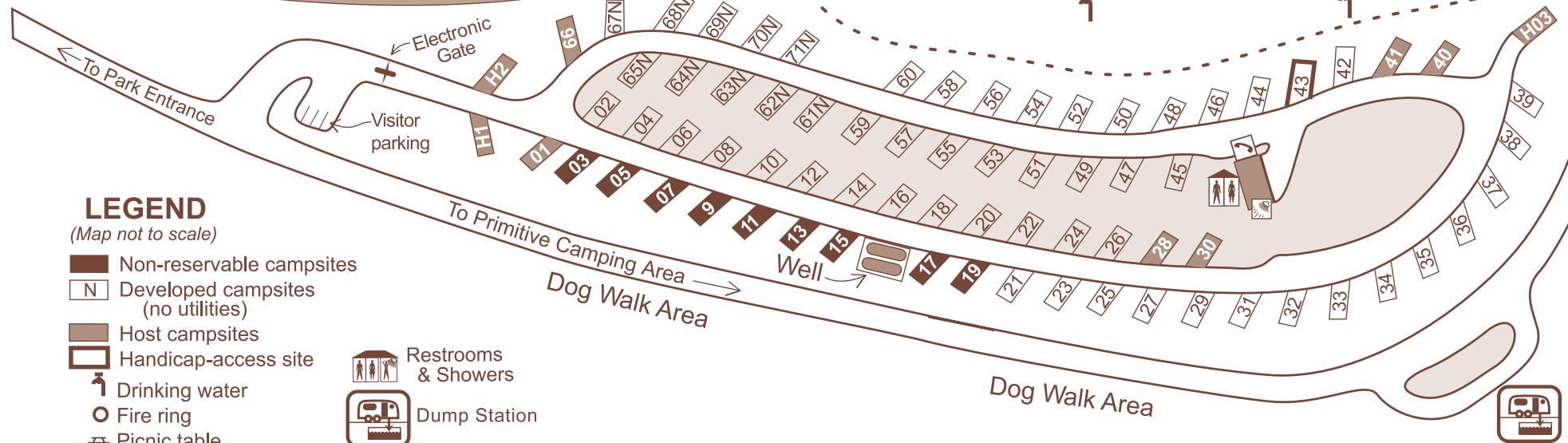
